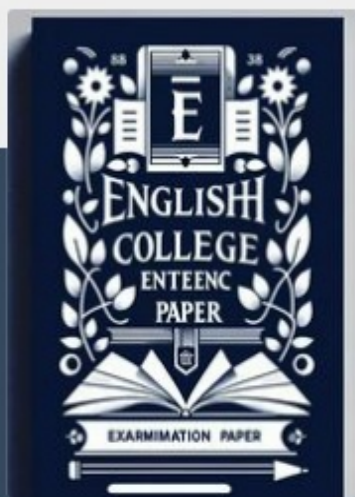

You probably know who Marie Curie was, but you may not have heard of Rachel Carson. Of the outstanding ladies listed below, who do you think was the most important woman of the past 100 years?

Jane Addams(1860-1935)

简·亚当斯 ( 1860-1935 )

Anyone who has ever been helped by a social worker has Jane Addams to thank. Addams helped the poor and worked for peace. She encouraged a sense of community(社区) by creating shelters and promoting education and services for people in need. In 1931, Addams became the first American woman to win the Nobel Peace Prize.

任何曾经得到社会工作者帮助的人都要感谢简·亚当斯。亚当斯帮助穷人并致力于和平。她通过创建庇护所和促进教育及服务，鼓励社区意识，帮助有需要的人。1931年，亚当斯成为首位获得诺贝尔和平奖的美国女性。

Rachel Carson(1907-1964)

瑞秋·卡森 ( 1907-1964 )

If it weren't for Rachel Carson, the environmental movement might not exist today. Her popular 1962 book *Silent Spring* raised awareness of the dangers of pollution and the harmful effects of chemicals on humans and on the world's lakes and oceans.

如果没有瑞秋·卡森，环保运动可能至今还不存在。她的畅销书《寂静的春天》（1962年）提高了人们对污染危险的认识，以及化学品对人类和世界湖泊、海洋的有害影响。

Sandra Day O'Connor(1930-present)

桑德拉·戴·奥康纳 ( 1930年至今 )

When Sandra Day O'Connor finished third in her class at Stanford Law School, in 1952, she could not find work at a law firm because she was a woman. She became an Arizona state senator(参议员) and, in 1981, the first woman to join the U.S. Supreme Court. O'Connor gave the deciding vote in many important cases during her 24 years on the top court.

当桑德拉·戴·奥康纳在1952年以斯坦福法学院第三名的成绩毕业时，她找不到律师事务所的工作，因为她是女性。她成为了亚利桑那州的州参议员，并于1981年成为首位加入美国最高法院的女性。在奥康纳在最高法院的24年任期内，她在许多重要案件中投下了决定性的一票。

Rosa Parks(1913-2005)

罗莎·帕克斯 ( 1913-2005 )

On December 1, 1955, in Montgomery, Alabama, Rosa Parks would not give up her seat on a bus to a passenger. Her simple act landed Parks in prison. But it also set off the Montgomery bus boycott. It lasted for more than a year, and kicked off the civil-rights movement. "The only tired I

was, was tired of giving in,"said Parks.

1955年12月1日，在阿拉巴马州蒙哥马利，罗莎·帕克斯拒绝在公交车上为一位乘客让座。她这个简单的行为让帕克斯进了监狱。但它也引发了蒙哥马利公交车抵制运动。这场抵制持续了一年多，并开启了民权运动。“我唯一感到疲惫的，就是屈服，”帕克斯说。

A warm drink of milk before bed has long been the best choice for those wanting a good night's sleep. But now a study has found it really does help people nod off—if it is milked from a cow at night.

喝一杯温暖的牛奶长期以来一直是那些想要睡个好觉的人的最佳选择。但现在一项研究发现，它确实有助于人们入睡——如果这牛奶是在夜间从奶牛身上挤出来的。

Researchers have discovered that “night milk” contains more melatonin(褪黑激素), which has been proven to help people feel sleepy and reduce anxiety.

研究人员发现，“夜间牛奶”含有更多的褪黑激素，已被证明有助于人们感到困倦并减少焦虑。

The study, by researchers from Seoul, South Korea, involved mice being fed with dried milk powder made from cows milked both during the day and at night.

这项由韩国首尔的研究人员进行的研究涉及喂养小鼠，这些小鼠被喂食由白天和夜间挤奶的奶牛制成的脱脂奶粉。

Those given night milk, which contained 10 times the amount of melatonin, were less active and less anxious than those fed with the milk collected during daytime, according to the study published in The Journal of Medicinal Food.

根据发表在《药用食品杂志》上的研究，那些被喂食含有褪黑激素量是白天挤奶的牛奶的10倍的夜间牛奶的小鼠，活动量较少，焦虑感也较轻。

Night milk quickened the start of sleep and caused the mice to sleep longer.

夜间牛奶加快了小鼠入睡的开始，并使它们睡得更久。

While the effect of cows milk harvested at different time has not been tested on humans up to now, taking melatonin drugs has been suggested to those who are struggling to fall asleep at night.

尽管到目前为止，不同时间收获的牛奶对人类的影响尚未经过测试，但已经建议那些晚上难以入睡的人服用褪黑素药物。

Previous studies have also indicated that milk can be excellent for helping sleep because of the calcium content, which helps people to relax.

以前的研究也表明，由于钙含量的原因，牛奶对于帮助睡眠非常有益，钙有助于人们放松。

Milk is also sugar-free and additive-free with nutritionists recommending skimmed milk as the best choice before bed as it is the least fattening. The more fat you take in before bedtime, the greater burden you will put on your body at night.

In the depths of the French Guianese rainforest, there still remain unusual groups of indigenous(土著的) people. Surprisingly, these people live largely by their own laws and their own social customs. And yet, people in this area are in fact French citizens because it has been a colony(殖民地) of the French Republic since 1946. In theory, they should live by the French law is often ignored or unknown, thus making them into an interesting area of “lawlessness” in the world.

在法属圭亚那雨林的深处，仍然存在着一些不同寻常的土著人群。令人惊讶的是，这些人大多遵循自己的法律和社交习俗生活。然而，这个地区的居民实际上是法国公民，因为它自1946年以来一直是法兰西共和国的殖民地。理论上，他们应该遵守法国法律，但实际上这些法律常常被忽视或不为人所知，因此使他们成为世界上一个有趣的“无法无天”的地区。

The lives of these people have finally been recorded thanks to the efforts of a Frenchman from Paris called Gin. Gin spent five months in early 2015 exploring the most remote corners of this area, which sits on the edge of the Amazon rainforest, with half its population of only 250,000 living in its capital, Cayenne.

多亏了一位名叫金的巴黎法国人的影响，这些人的生活终于被记录下来。金在2015年初花了五个月的时间探索这个位于亚马逊雨林边缘、一半人口仅25万且生活在其首府卡宴的地区最偏远的角落。

“I have a special love for the French Guianese people. I have worked there on and off for almost ten years,” says Gin. “I’ve been able to keep firm friendships with them. Thus I have been allowed to gain access to their living environment. I don’t see it as a lawless land. But rather I see it as an area of freedom.”

“我对法属圭亚那人民有着特殊的爱。我已经在那里断断续续地工作了将近十年，”金说。“我已经能够与他们建立起牢固的友谊。因此，我被允许进入他们的生活环境。我不认为这是一个无法无天的地方。相反，我认为这是一个自由的领域。”

“I wanted to show the audience a photographic record touching upon the uncivilized life,” continues Gin. “I prefer to work in black and white, which allows me to show different specific worlds more clearly.”

“我想向观众展示一个关于未开化生活的摄影记录，”金继续说。“我更喜欢用黑白摄影，这让我能够更清晰地展示不同的特定世界。”

His black-and-white pictures present a world almost lost in time. These pictures show people seemingly pushed into a world that they were unprepared for. These local citizens now have to balance their traditional self-supporting hunting lifestyle with the lifestyle offered by the modern French Republic, which brings with it not only necessary state welfare, but also alcoholism, betrayal and even suicide.

A new collection of photos brings an unsuccessful Antarctic voyage back to life.

一组新的照片集让一次失败的南极探险重新回到了人们的视线。

Frank Hurley's pictures would be outstanding - undoubtedly first-rate photo-journalism if they had been made last week. In fact, they were shot from 1914 through 1916, most of them after a disastrous shipwreck (海难), by a cameraman who had no reasonable expectation of survival. Many of the images were stored in an ice chest, under freezing water, in the damaged wooden ship.

弗兰克·赫尔利的照片如果放在上周拍摄，无疑将是杰出的一流新闻摄影作品。实际上，这些照片是在1914年至1916年间拍摄的，大部分是在一次灾难性的海难之后，由一位没有生存希望的摄影师拍摄的。许多照片被储存在一个冰柜里，在受损的木船下，被冰冻的水覆盖。

The ship was the Endurance, a small, tight, Norwegian-built three-master that was intended to take Sir Ernest Shackleton and a smakk crew of seamen and scientists, 27 men in all, to the southernmost shore of Antarctica's Weddell Sea. From that point Shackleton wanted to force a passage by dog sled (雪橇) across the continent. The journey was intended to achieve more than what Captain Robert Falcon Scott had done. Captain Scott had reached the South Pole early in 1912 but had died with his four companions on the march back.

那艘船是耐力号，一艘小型、紧凑、挪威制造的三桅帆船，原本计划搭载欧内斯特·沙克尔顿爵士和他的一小队水手和科学家，共27人，前往南极洲威德尔海的最南端。从那里，沙克尔顿计划用狗拉雪橇穿越大陆。这次旅程旨在实现比罗伯特·法尔康·斯科特船长在1912年初到达南极点并返回途中与他的四个伙伴一起死去的成就更多。

As writer Caroline Alexander makes clear in her forceful and well-researched story  
正如作家卡罗琳·亚历山大在她有力且研究充分的故事中所明确指出的，

The Endurance, adventuring was even then a thoroughly commercial effort. Scott's last journey, completed as he lay in a tent dying of cold and hunger, caught the world's imagination, and a film made in his honor drew crowds. Shackleton, a onetime British merchant-navy officer who had got to within 100 miles of the South Pole in 1908, started a business before his 1914 voyage to make money from movie and still photography. Frank Hurley, a confident and gifted Australian photographer who knew the Antarctic, was hired to make the images, most of which have never before been published.

耐力号的冒险甚至在当时也是一项彻底的商业活动。斯科特的最后一次旅程，在他躺在帐篷里死于寒冷和饥饿时完成，吸引了全世界的想象力，一部为他制作的影片吸引了众多观众。沙克尔顿，一位曾经的英国商船海军军官，曾在1908年到达南极洲罗斯海的100英里内，他在1914年的航行前开始做生意，以从电影和静态摄影中赚钱。弗兰克·赫尔利，一位自信且有才华的澳大利亚摄影师，他了解南极洲，被雇来拍摄这些照片，其中大部分以前从未公开发表过。

Reading can be a social activity. Think of the people who belong to book groups. They choose books to read and then need to discuss them. Now, the website BookCrossing.com turns the page on the traditional idea of a book groups.

Members go on the site and register the books they own and would like to share. BookCrossing provides an identification number to stick inside the book. Then the person leaves place, hoping that the book will have an adventure, traveling far and wide with each new reader who finds it.

Bruce Pederson, the managing director of BookCrossing, says, "The two things that change your life are the people you meet and books you read. BookCrossing combines both"

BookCrossing的总经理布鲁斯·佩德森说：“改变你生活的两个东西是你所遇到的人和你所读的书。BookCrossing将这两者结合在一起。”

Members leave books on park benches and buses, in train stations and coffee shops. Whoever finds their book will go to the site and record where they found it.

成员们将书籍留在公园长椅、公交车上、火车站和咖啡店。任何找到书的人都会去网站记录他们在哪里找到的。

People who find a book can also leave a journal entry describing what they thought of it. E-mails are then sent to the BookCrossers to keep them updated about their books have been found. Bruce Pederson says the idea is for people not to be selfish by keeping a book to gather dust on a shelf at home.

BookCrossing is part of a trend among people who want to get back to the "real" and not the virtual(虚拟). The site now has more than one million members in more than one hundred thirty-five countries.

Five years ago,when I taught art at a school in Seattle, I used Tinkertoys as a test at the beginning of a term to find out something about my students.I put a small set of Tinkertoys in front of each student, and said:“Make something out of the Tinkertoys. You have 45 minutes today—and 45 minutes each day for the rest of the week”

五年前，当我在西雅图的一所学校教艺术时，我用Tinkertoys作为学期初的测试，以了解我的学生们。我在每个学生面前放了一套小Tinkertoys，并说：“用Tinkertoys制作一些东西。你今天有45分钟——这周剩下的每天也有45分钟。”

A few students hesitated to start ,They waited to see what the rest of the class would do.

Several others checked the instructions and made something according to one of the model plans provided. Another group built something out of their own imaginatings.

一些学生犹豫着开始，他们等待看其他同学会怎么做。还有一些人查看了说明书，并根据提供的模型计划制作了一些东西。另一组则根据自己的想象力建造了东西。

Once I had a boy who worked experimentally with Tinkertoys in his free time.His constructions filled a shelf in the art classroom and a good part of his bedroom at home.I was delighted at the presence of such a student.Here was an exceptionally creative mind at work. His presence meant that I had an unexpected teaching assistant in class whose creativity would infect ( 感染 ) other students.

有一次，我遇到了一个男孩，他在空闲时间里用Tinkertoys进行实验。他的构造作品填满了艺术教室的一个架子，以及他家里卧室的大部分空间。我对这个学生的出现感到非常高兴。这里有一个异常有创造力的头脑在工作。他的存在意味着我在课堂上有一个意想不到的教学助手，他的创造力会感染其他学生。

Encouraging this kind of thinking has a downside, the ask of losing those students who had a different style of thinking.Without fail one would declare,“But I’m just not creative.”
